CRIME

While crime is down by 15% in our area this year - and burglaries and thefts from vehicles are down 35% - the last few months have seen an unusual spate of incidents in West IIsley which were listed by PC Matt Allen at September's parish council meeting. There was damage to a vehicle in March, fences in April and crops in May. In June, a guad bike was stolen and the pavilion and four vehicles were broken into in a single night. July and August saw four thefts, ranging from a horse box to a bin. In all, 15 crimes were reported in six months, 85% of which have yet to be solved. Since the parish council meeting, two people have reported that someone tried their back doors one evening while they were watching television and a lock was apparently broken on the same night at the pavilion, although nothing was stolen. PC Allen suggested a possible link to travellers and warned that people from Wales and

Bristol might come in occasionally to break into a few cars. He urged everyone to be vigilant. Anyone who sees a crime being committed should dial 999. Any information about these incidents should be reported by dialling 101.

SPEEDING

September's parish council meeting heard renewed concerns about speeding at either end of the village, especially past the recreation ground and the Malthouse. Speed cameras will be in operation in the coming weeks. Don't get caught out!

PLAY AREA




