

West Ilsley Tennis Club - Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct sets out the standards of behaviour expected of all members, visitors, and users of the West Ilsley Tennis Court. It is in place to help ensure the court can be enjoyed safely, respectfully and fairly by everyone.

Important Information

• All play must be booked via the online booking system:

https://westilsleytennis.jezzam.com

- Non-members must book online and pay the court fee of £10/hour. Nonmembers can only book up to 24 hours in advance.
- The court is to be used for tennis and netball only all other activities are strictly prohibited.

1. Respect for Others

- Be courteous to all players, spectators, and committee members.
- Avoid disruptive or antisocial behaviour.
- Respect other people's bookings and court time.

2. Fair Use of the Court

- Use the court only during your booking time.
- Do not enter the court during someone else's booking.
- Keep noise to a reasonable level.

3. Court Access

- Use the access code provided in your booking confirmation to enter the court.
- Do not share the code with anyone who is not part of your booked session.
- Always lock the gate after your session ends.

4. Care of the Court and Equipment

- The net should only be adjusted using the winding handle at the side.
- Do not adjust the central net strap.
- Please use the winding handle at the side of the net to raise the net before play
- Please make sure the net is slackened a couple of turns after play to preserve equipment.
- Use appropriate footwear (non-marking tennis shoes). No studs/spikes are permitted on the court.
- Do not bring bikes, scooters, pets or glass containers onto the court.
- Leave the court tidy after use.
- Please take all your belongings with you and remove any litter when you leave.

5. Supervision and Young People

- Children under 13 must be supervised by an adult.
- All users are expected to behave responsibly and safely.

6. Safety and Conduct

- Players are responsible for their own and others' safety.
- Report any damage or safety concerns to the committee.
- Do not misuse the court or surrounding area.
- Anyone behaving inappropriately may be asked to leave.

7. General Behaviour

- Treat the court as a shared community facility.
- Be mindful of others using the recreation ground.
- Offensive, aggressive or damaging behaviour is not acceptable.
