
WEST ILSLEY FIREWORKS

On Sunday 5th November the village fireworks took place. Thanks to Tom and Will Carlisle who organised the bonfire and to Tony for setting off the fireworks and the rest of the Village Hall team and their helpers for the BBQ, a very successful evening took place. Thanks also to all who donated so generously into the bucket - we made about £900 for Village Hall Funds.

MALTHOUSE WELL

The Malthouse well reading has been dropping since March and should bottom out in December. It now stands at 20.03 metres (approx. 66ft) below ground level which is the lowest it's been since December 2012. If anyone is interested in our local weather there is a website showing in real-time a moving graphic that predicts with good accuracy rain for the hours expected next 3 (http://meteoradar.co.uk/expected-rainfall#). It can be customised specifically for West Ilsley and it's a good check before deciding to walk the dogs or wash the car.



COUNTRY NOTES

4th November

A clear sky, the feel of frost. An enormous full moon, 14% larger and three times brighter than normal. The moon is at it's perigee, the point in it's orbit where it comes closest to the earth. It shines a silvery light reflected from the white frosted ground; at midnight I can see for a mile. This is a woodcock moon, so named as there was a belief that woodcock flew to the moon in spring and returned

with the first full moon of November. They are arriving now, not from the moon but from the freezing north; The Baltic States, Scandinavia and Russia. Results from a satellite tracking programme carried out by the Game & Wildlife Conservation Trust has shown that three individual birds from Central Siberia have travelled 4,500 miles to get here.



A huddle of common puffballs along Old Street have now matured, when prodded by a finger or bombed by a rain drop they live up to their name and puff millions of tiny spores into the air to be dispersed far and wide by the lightest of breezes. Their scientific name is Lycoperdon, From the Greek lyco for wolf and perdon "to break wind" Appropriately the Spanish call

them pedo de lobo; wolf farts. Perdix


