Progress being made connecting West Berkshire

Now we need action from you. The Berkshire Superfast broadband programme is on track to get 90% of Berkshire premises access to Superfast Broadband, and the other 10% to standard broadband (2MBit/sec or faster), by 2015. The Government has approved the Berkshire plan and the next stage is procurement.

In order to get the best value for money and to get the maximum number of homes with access to superfast broadband, we need to show demand. I am asking all constituents, who live outside of Newbury and Hungerford, to register their interest in getting superfast broadband by going to http://www.superfastberkshire.org.uk/. This will show potential bidders that there is a market in West Berkshire and it will hopefully speed up

delivery to your area. Please note, that by registering on this site, you are not committed to taking superfast broadband when it comes – but it may just help it get to your area. Please pass this website on to all your friends and neighbours and encourage them to register too.




