NOVEMBER NATURE NOTES

A month that perhaps can be summed up by the words of the 19th century poet Thomas Hood, these are the first and last verses from his poem November No sun, no moon No morn, no noon No dawn, no dusk, no proper time of day No sky, no earthly view No distance looking blue

No warmth, no cheerfulness, no healthful ease No comfortable feel in any member No shade, no shine, no butterflies, no bees No fruits, no flowers, no leaves, no birds November!

In a similar vein my notes for the 16th November:-A misty morning. Grey wood pigeons fly unheard across a soft, damp grey sky. Invisible horizons, the land diffusing seamlessly into the sky. The few remaining yellow blackthorn leaves dot the hedgerow resembling a pointillist painting, these merge with neighbouring rusty brown leaves of oak interspersed with the bare boughs of ash. Condensing mist drips onto already sodden bracken, no longer the burnt sienna of September but a dark, rusty iron oxide colour. All is very still. On an overhead wire a kestrel peers down through hunched shoulders, feathers fluffed against the damp. The bridleway is carpeted in fallen leaves in various stages of decay. The skidding hoof prints of ponies and the precise slots of fallow puddling the leaves into the mud, all to be recycled and resurrected into future new life forms. A light breeze springs up from the north dislodging fresher leaves which form a sprinkled pattern of brighter colours over the dark mire.

We do have a very rare winter visitor in the parish. A great grey shrike has been with us since the end of October and has been spotted several times throughout November, south of the Ridgeway. A distinctive black, white and grey bird a little smaller than a blackbird but with very different habits, this is a predator! It's latin name is Lanius excubitor after the imperial guards of the Byzantine emperors and sentinel like it perches conspicuously on top of trees and bushes where it can spot it's prey of small mammals and birds. These are dispatched with it's strong bill and then they are often impaled on a thorn or barbed wire fence where they are dismembered. This habit lending it the name of "Butcher Bird". 
