



COUNTRY NOTES

18th April

Four swallows and three house martins circle the village pond; the swallows swoop low, sipping water from the surface; the martins hawk for flying insects. The water in the pond is the colour of milky coffee, not the most welcoming drink for these new arrivals but it doesn't seem to bother them. It is this colour because it hasn't rained for a month, the water level is low; on the positive side the falling level has exposed areas of soft mud, the perfect building material for their adobe nests.

The house martin is a lucky bird, it is said that any house on which it builds its nest is forever blessed with happiness. Conversely it is also considered unlucky to knock down a martins nest.

The following quotation is taken from "A glossary of Berkshire Words and Phrases" written in 1888 by one Major B Lowsley

"Where martins build their nests poverty never reigns. No one will take the eggs of a martin or kill these birds and good luck and prosperity are believed to come under the roof around which they build. Their nests are only destroyed when feathers protruding from the side aperture show that sparrows have taken possession and turned out the rightful owners; then a long pole I brought and the mud structure poked to pieces to the destruction of the eggs or young family of the pirates. considered a sign of bad luck to those living in a house if martins having once built around the roof discontinue to do so." 


