- 2. Precept or rates or Levies. Precept raised by £250 from last year. In addition we received a one-off £6,332 CIL.
- 6. All other payments. We spent less on village maintenance and improvements this year than last year by £1,152.
- 7. Balances carried forward. These have increased by spending less than we have received, particularly augmented by the CIL. However this build up of reserves is necessary given our plans for some expensive village maintenance plans in the near future.
