

The presentation will be fully illustrated and will include a demonstration of coaching tunes on a coach horn. That will sound impressive in our church. The presentation will last for approximately one hour and will be followed by wine and nibbles which will be included in the requested entrance donation of £5.00. Proceeds going towards church funds. MAY'S FARMING NEWS

May has been very wet and has hindered our fertiliser spreading and spraying of pesticides on the crops. Slugs have also been a considerable problem and can be seen shredding the leaves of all crops, particularly the Spring Barley which was the last planted. The Winter Barley has been sprayed and is now out "in ear" and the Spring Barley and Winter Wheat will have to be sprayed again for Netblotch and Septoria in June. The Winter Oilseed Rape will only require dessication with Roundup and this is carried out preharvest which enables an even ripening of the crop to make harvesting easier.

We have recently acquired a couple of one year old Dexter heifers, Deirdre and Delilah, from a local farmer. They can be seen playing with the older beef cattle above the cricket pitch and are considerably smaller, shorter legged and have a slighter frame than the other breeds in the field. They are a renowned breed from South West Ireland and have a superior beef quality and flavour.

There are now no crops left in store from last harvest and this will enable us to clean the stores and service the drier ready for the coming harvest hence you may occasionally hear the drier fans start up.

All the younger sheep (Tegs) have now lambed at Folly Farm and can be seen in the field alongside the beef cattle. The second lambing in May was very successful with an even proportion of single and twin lambs. Peter Carlisle



COMMUNITY MINIBUS SERVICES

Community Minibus (Handybus) schemes are often assisted financially by the local Council. They are primarily intended forgroup bookings, although if space is available individual bookings may also be taken.Whilst the focus is on the elderly and mobility impaired people, these schemes tend to provide specific solutions that complement the public bus services.
