Repeat Prescriptions: The Practice prides itself on its excellent safety record for prescribing. Whilst we understand that you may find it inconvenient to collect prescriptions monthly, or to attend your annual review, there is a good reason that the practice operates this way. Please rest assured that your safety remains the primary concern of the Practice. Please understand that the dispensers and receptionists are only

complying with the Doctors orders when they insist you have your review before they can hand you your medicine. We would like to remind patients that we are trying to improve the ease of ordering repeat prescriptions and this can now be done by exploring the new practice website. Its well worth a visit if you haven't seen it!

The cost of prescriptions will be increasing nationally to £7.85 from 1st April. You may pay by credit/debit card (20p additional), cash or cheque. If you require frequent medicines, it may be cheaper to have a prepayment certificate. Please ask at dispensary.




